

Susanna Hurley's Adult Camp 2015

Campers will arrive at MKEC late morning/ lunchtime ready for a 1.15 'Welcome Meeting' and the first group will be ready to ride at 2pm, times of Friday's ride will be given prior to camp so there'll be no last minute rush. Camp area is clearly signed once through main yard, this will take you past the XC course to the campers stabling area where you can set up camp overlooked by the stables and individuals stables allocated, boxes/tents sited. Stables will be equipped with woodchip bedding, own water buckets and horse feed & hay are required. Please bring your own mucking out equipment, wheelbarrow etc. Hay and Haylage are available on site see price on registration form. Horse's passports to be presented at welcome meeting and balances for camp settled. Camp is fully catered, campers need only bring their own supply of chocolate and alcohol. Electricity for charging phones and suchlike is provided. Guests are welcome to visit camp and ask that you notify me of any visitors for security reasons and whether they will be joining us for any meals. Non-riding guests can attend the weekend for a fee to cover camping and catering. We do not currently have 'hook-up' facilities.

Stables begin at 7.30am, perfect for shaking off a hangover, lessons commence at 9.00am! Hot showers, toilets and sinks are at camp. Lessons will be in groups of 4-6 depending on lesson content and groups will vary for different disciplines although half hour private sessions can be requested in advance or over the weekend! Saturday will consist of two lessons each and depending on discipline will be either up at the main yard (indoor/outdoor school), Show Jump arena, Dressage Arena or XC Course. Camp is tailored and run in a very personal/bespoke way so groups vary and the course of action for the following lesson will be decided upon after each training session so that each combination of horse and rider work on what they need rather than being clumped together and all jumping or all going XC. All the facilities can be used but to be co-ordinated by me. I will be meeting all riders at the time stated at the venue stated, not returning to camp too meet the next ride. Please feel free to warm up for these lessons but I would ask that until I am present on the XC course warm up is kept to walk and trot only H&S, Insurance purposes, we have to adhere to rules so thank you! Current hats & body protectors MUST be worn on the XC Course and a hat at ALL times when mounted. Sunday will be 7.30 stables and 9.00 lessons commence with lessons in the morning before lunch, after lunch we can pack up camp, check for any litter and return our stables to their unused appearance. Tack and equipment, try to avoid bringing brand new equipment to camp in case the 'breaking in' process causes any soreness – especially new riding boots/hat! If you're unsure about the fitting of your saddle etc then have this checked this prior to camp. Remember different equipment for different disciplines so if you're fortunate enough to have both a jump & Dressage saddle you'll need both but most importantly the specific numnahs and girths which go with the saddles, same for different bits/bridles and boots etc for jumping or XC or flatwork, studs, spare clean/dry numnahs, boots, etc. We're in England ... water proofs are handy (human & equine) even if hopefully not required, as could sun cream be, who knows!?!
