In hand – commencing at 9am

Class 1: Best condition

(Will be split into Grass Kept and Stabled if sufficient entries)

Class 2: Novice handler (adult & child)

(Will be split adult & child if sufficient entries)

Class 3: Best Youngster (horses not to be more than 3 years of age from Jan 1st 2015)

Class 4 – Mountain and Moorland

(Will be split into Large and Small breeds if sufficient entries)

Class 5 – Best Cob

(Will be split between Traditional and non-traditional if sufficient entries)

Class 6 – Best Veteran

(Horses to be 15 years or older, passport proof required)

In hand championship Championship for all 1st and 2nd Class competitors for Class 1-6

Ridden – not before 12 noon

Class 7 – Best turned out

(Will be split between plaited and non-plaited if sufficient entries)

Class 8: Lead Rein/ First ridden

(Will be split if sufficient entries)

Class 9: Beginner Showing/Novice Ridden - Open to riders any age and cantering optional

(This class is for beginners to showing and novice or nervous riders and the class will not canter as a group. Competitors can be led and have outside assistance within reason. Please enter in the spirit intended.)

Class 10 – Riding Club Horse or Pony (will be required to jump a small jump)

(Will be split between horses and ponies if sufficient entries)

Class 11: Foreign Breeds

Class 12: Coloured Horse or Pony (to include odd coloureds)

(Will be split between coloured and odd coloured if sufficient entries)

Ridden Championship for all 1st and 2nd place competitors from Class 7-12

Fun classes – Starting at 9am. Can be ridden or In-hand

Class 13 – Handsomest gelding

Class 14 - Prettiest mare

Class 15 – Pony the judge would most like to take home

Class 16-Best Mane and Tail

Class 17 – Best fancy dress

Rules

1. The Committee reserves the right to accept or refuse entry
2. The Committee accept no responsibility for loss or injury to horses, riders, spectators, vehicles or property.
3. Objections are to be made in writing to the show secretary on completion of the event with a deposit of £10. Any persons making frivolous objections forfeit their deposit.
4. All instructions from show officials and stewards must be obeyed
5. The Judges decision is final.
6. Age of rider as on the day of the show.
7. Age of horse is taken from 1st January of the birth year (horses born in 2011 will be classed as 4 years)
8. No horse/pony under 4 years maybe ridden on the show ground.
9. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter any class without prior notice
10. All competitors must be able to control their horses.
11. No galloping or cantering allowed in show ground. Please use designated warm up area.
12. No unsportsmanlike like behaviour will be tolerated.
13. It is recommended that all competitors have their own insurance.
14. All riders must wear protective headgear that must be securely fastened at all times when mounted. All hats must be to the current British Safety Standard. Hard hats must also be worn by all exhibitors 14 years and under in all in hand classes. Suitable heeled riding footwear must be worn whilst mounted.
15. Stallions are welcome but must be handled/ridden by someone of at least 16 years and must wear a ribbon or disks and must be bitted.
16. Horses must not be tied to your transport and left unattended.
17. **Dogs to be kept on leads and cleared up after.**
